Churches Reopened – It is good to have Churches open again for congregations of up to 50. However, we have to be extremely careful with all social interactions. This includes attending Church. As we know, the level of virus within the country is much greater now than at the time of the previous re-opening in July. This also applies to Co. Mayo. **Volunteers** –Thanks to those who have volunteered to act as stewards. However, as stewards may need to have some contact with churchgoers, it may not be appropriate to task anyone with underlining medical conditions, or those of pension age, with such interaction.

Tickets - for next weekend's Masses (December 14th & 15th) are now available to be picked up from the back of the Church. Admission to weekend Masses is by *"Ticket Only"* and will be rigorously enforced. Please note, possession of a "ticket" does not guarantee admission if you arrive late and the doors are closed!

Church Decorating for Christmas – takes place on Sun, Dec 6th at 6.30pm. If free for an hour, please give a socially distanced hand. Many thanks to those who have already done a lot of work this week by putting up trees and cribs. **Volunteer Readers needed** – for Christmas Masses. If you would like to read let Fr. Martin know this coming week. **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for the Season of Advent** – continues this week after 7.00 pm Mass on Wed.

Christmas Masses – For most people, attending a religious service on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day is very much part of the Christmas Season. Unfortunately, due to the present pandemic, things will have to be a little different this year. Even though it will be possible to view Christmas Masses from Straide online, many parishioners value being physically present and receiving Holy Communion. If the level of demand exists, and if stewards are available, it may be possible to have an additional Mass on Christmas Eve and on Christmas Day. This would allow 200 people to safely attend a Mass over the course of Christmas Eve / Christmas Day. If such an arrangement would facilitate people who would like to attend, please let me know by December 13th, as planning needs to take place well in advance
